Call for nominations

The Bank for International Settlements invites nominations research economists from BIS member central banks who wish to develop a research project at the BIS.

We particularly welcome proposals with a focus on three themes:

- characteristics and nature of financial intermediation, with an emphasis on financial innovation and the digital economy
- global economy and spillovers
- post-crisis monetary and financial stability frameworks

Scope of the programme and selection criteria

The objective of the programme is to enhance the understanding of issues of strategic importance for central banks through collaboration with BIS economists on high-quality research.

Selection criteria for participants in the CBRF are:

- the policy relevance of the proposed research topic to central banks and the BIS
- the applicant's research track record and publication list
- the potential for collaboration with BIS economists

Terms and conditions

Nominations should be accompanied by:

- A curriculum vitae
- A detailed research proposal with timeline for completion of the project suggestions for possible co-authorship with BIS staff, and location preference (Basel, Hong Kong SAR or Mexico City)
- One recent research paper authored by the candidate

Call for nominations is circulated twice a year with deadlines on 31 March and 30 September.

Expressions of interest should be sent by staff of each central bank to the Head of Research of the same institution, together with a project proposal.

Nominations from BIS member Central Banks. Nominations should be gathered by the Head of Research (or the senior central bank official responsible for research).

Selected candidates will spend up to a total of three months in Basel, or at one of the BIS representative offices (Hong Kong AR and Mexico City).

The selected CBRF fellows will continue to receive their salary from their home institution.

The BIS offers a monthly stipend, plus accommodation and travel costs.
